

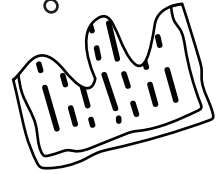
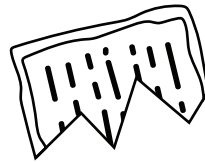
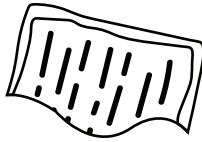
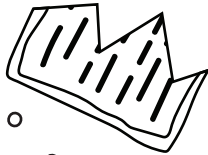
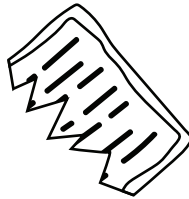
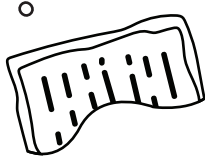
'S SEDER PLATE

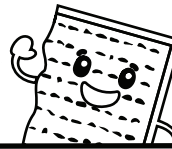
